Wilson finished third in her weight class, while repeating as region and district champion, at the state championships this past weekend.

The Estacado standout was lauded by her coach, Danny Douglas, for her skill set and her individual performance.

"She was the first ... marquee athlete in our program," Douglas said. "She was the first girl to not only be district champion, but the only regional champion. She's the first Region I champion two years going. This is the second year she's been All-State, and she was the first girl in Lubbock ISD to be All-State."

Douglas added that the Matadors added another wrestler to the exclusive club, making Estacado the only school with two female All-State performers.

Wilson, who started off as a basketball player two summers prior before voluntarily walking over to wrestling, is being courted by numerous universities to wrestle for them, including the defending champions in King University.

"You couldn't find a better young lady," said Douglas. "Her teammates like her, she likes her teammates, (and) she loves the sport. She's one of those young ladies that'll do anything you ask of her."
